Puppy Land: Single marked bird or dummy

Puppy Cup to winner of aggregate. Prize, sash & certificate 1st to 3rd place

Conditions of Entry:

- 1 All Championship dogs must be purebred & registered on the DogsNZ Register Part 1.
- 2 Full pedigree name and registration number must be supplied at time of entry.
- 3 All competitors must be a financial member of an NZGTA affiliated club as well as a member of the NZGTA.
- 4 All competitors and dogs compete at their own risk.
- 5 **A current dosing certificate must be provided before dogs will be allowed on to trial grounds.** (For more info go to <https://www.sheepmeasles.co.nz/>)
- 6 NZGTA Rules & Regulations will be available with the Club Secretary.
- 7 The committee reserves the right to make changes to grounds or judges if required.
- 8 Eight or more dogs to be entered for third place trophy to be awarded, five or more dogs to be entered for second place trophy to be awarded.
- 9 Retriever Walk Up – if a ballot is required, it will be held at the Tai Tapu Pub on the 29th October at 6pm
- 10 Shotguns will not be used in this trial. An alternative firing device will be used.
