Puppy Water: Single marked bird or dummy Entry Fee, Aggregate \$10

Puppy Cup to winner of aggregate. Prize, sash & certificate 1st to 3rd place

Conditions of Entry:

- 1) All championship dogs must be purebred & registered on DogsNZ Register Part 1.
- 2) Full pedigree name and registration number must be supplied at time of entry.
- 3) All competitors and dogs compete at their own risk.
- 4) Engraving to be the responsibility & cost of the winner.
- 5) NZGTA Rules & Regulations will be available at the Secretary's office.
- 6) The committee reserves the right to replace judges and change grounds if unforeseen circumstances.
- 7) Eight or more dogs to be entered for third place trophy to be awarded
- 8) Shotguns will not be used in this trial. An alternative firing device will be used.
- 9) Retriever Walk Up A ballot will be held at the Tai Tapu Pub on the 13th Nov 2025 at 6:30pm, if required. The draw for order of running will be made at the Captain's briefing.
